SUBJECT: New Apprenticeable Occupation: Licensed Clinical Mental Health Counselor

(LCMHC)

- 1. **Purpose.** To inform the staff of OA, State Apprenticeship Agencies (SAA), Registered Apprenticeship program sponsors, and other Registered Apprenticeship partners of the following new apprenticeable occupation: Licensed Clinical Mental Health Counselor (LCMHC).
- 2. <u>Action Requested</u>. OA staff should familiarize themselves with this bulletin and the attached Work Process Schedule and Related Instruction Outline, as a source for developing apprenticeship standards and/or providing technical assistance.

Licensed Clinical Mental Health Counselor (LCMHC) will be added to the List of Occupations Recognized as Apprenticeable by OA located on www.apprenticeship.gov. A suggested Work Process Schedule and Related Instruction Outline are attached.

3. Summary and Background.

- a. Summary The occupation Licensed Clinical Mental Health Counselor (LCMHC) was submitted by Ms. Nicole Field, Apprenticeship Training Representative, Region I Office of Apprenticeship on behalf of The College of New Jersey, was processed by Joseph P. Taylor and approved by the OA Acting Administrator on July 16, 2025.
- b. Background –

New/Revised Occupation Background - Under 29 CFR section 29.4, an occupation for a RAP must meet the following criteria to be determined apprenticeable:

- a) Involve skills that are customarily learned in a practical way through a structured, systematic program of on-the job supervised learning;
- b) Be clearly identified and commonly recognized throughout an industry;
- c) Involve the progressive attainment of manual, mechanical, or technical skills and knowledge which, in accordance with the industry standard for the occupation, would require the completion of at least 4,000 hours of on-the-job learning to attain; and
- d) Require related instruction to supplement the on-the job learning.

Demonstrates the ability to examine systemic, cultural, and environmental factors that affect lifespan development, functioning, behavior, resilience, and overall wellness.
